<b>Day 1 15 Sept 2018 Saturday</b>	<p><b>KUALA LUMPUR / NARITA</b></p> <p>Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) for pleasant flight to Narita, Tokyo.</p>
<b>Day 2 16 Sept 2018 Sunday</b>	<p><b>NARITA – TOKYO</b></p> <p>Embark on city tour of Tokyo – <b>Asakusa Kannon Temple, Nakamise Street</b>. Drive pass <b>Imperial Palace, National Diet Building</b>. Later, visit the <b>Tokyo Sky Tree</b>. Congress Registration and collection of program books and bags.</p> <p>Later in the afternoon, transfer for the <b>Opening Ceremony and Welcome Reception of IWA World Water Congress &amp; Exhibition 2018 at Tokyo Big Sight</b>.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>(Lunch included) Return transfers provided</i></p>

<b>Day 4 18 Sept 2018 Tuesday</b>	<p><b>TOKYO (Tokyo Big Sight)</b></p> <p>Morning – proceed for <b>Full Day IWA World Water Congress &amp; Exhibition</b> Evening – transfer for dinner at local restaurant</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>(Breakfast &amp; Dinner included) Return transfers provided</i></p>
<b>Day 5 19 Sept 2018 Wednesday</b>	<p><b>TOKYO (Tokyo Big Sight)</b></p> <p>Morning – proceed for <b>Full Day IWA World Water Congress &amp; Exhibition</b> Evening – transfer for dinner at local restaurant</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>(Breakfast &amp; Dinner included) Return transfers provided</i></p>
<b>Day 6 20 Sept 2018 Thursday</b>	<p><b>TOKYO (Tokyo Big Sight)</b></p> <p>Morning – proceed for <b>Full Day IWA World Water Congress &amp; Exhibition</b> Evening – transfer for <b>Gala Evening at Hotel Nikko Daiba</b>. <b>Day 7 21 Sept 2018 Friday</b>	<p><b>EXTENDED STUDY TOUR: TOKYO / MT. FUJI / LAKE KAWAGUCHI</b></p> <p>After breakfast, proceed to <b>Mt. Fuji – 5<sup>th</sup> Station</b>. Then, to <b>Oshino Hakkai</b> – a touristy set of eight ponds located between lake Kawaguchiko and lake Yamanakako. Tonight, dip in an <b>Onsen</b> (Japanese Hot Spring) at the hotel.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>(Breakfast, Lunch &amp; Dinner included)</i></p>

<p><b>Day 8</b> <b>22 Sept 2018</b> <b>Saturday</b></p>	<p><b>EXTENDED STUDY TOUR: LAKE KAWAGUCHI / YOKOHAMA / TOKYO</b></p> <p>Depart to <b>Yokohama</b> – a rapidly developed city as Japan’s prominent port city following the end of Japan’s relative isolation in the mid-19<sup>th</sup> century. Upon arrival, visit Yokohama Water Bureau, <b>Ramen Museum</b> – where an entire museum is devoted to the ubiquitous Chinese noodle, <b>Yamashita Park</b> – a public park that stretches about 750 metres along Yokohama’s waterfront, <b>Yokohama Chinatown</b> – the largest Chinatown in Japan, <b>Minato Mirai 21</b> – a seaside urban area in central of Yokohama. In the evening, stroll along <b>Ginza</b> or <b>Shinzu</b> – Tokyo’s most famous upmarket shopping, dining and entertainment district.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>(Breakfast, Lunch &amp; Dinner included)</i></p>

## Visa Requirement

Malaysian nationals holding biometric passport compliance with ICAO standard do not need visa to enter Japan for a short term stay not more than 90 days if your purpose of visit is for tourism, transit, business meeting, visiting friends and relatives in Japan.

The Government of Japan implemented visa exemption for Malaysia nationals holding biometric passport compliance with ICAO standard since July 2013. From our understanding, all passports issued by the Malaysia government both in Malaysia and foreign missions abroad are all ICAO compliant by **end of January 2017**.
